LASHING CERTIFICATE

Currently, the evaluation of a professional and the issuance of a written/photographic report with the technical note, most of the time is a requirement of owners and/or their Freight Forwarders, for general unitized in Flat Rack containers of 20' or 40'.

<u>Note:</u> Failure to comply with this request, thus resulting in the non-issuance of the physical report, may result in the unfeasibility of shipping containers, generating additional burdens for exporters. In addition to harmful setbacks to the agreements signed for the receipt of cargo.





UNITIZATION/DESUNITIZATION OF CONTAINERS

This service consists of follow-up and technical instruction for unitization and/or desunitization of containerized cargo. 
